What is the Most Valuable Scouter Award? It is a district award that recognizes an individual leader on the unit level that has given outstanding service to your unit. It is not a replacement to the District Award of Merit, Scoutmaster of the Year, or Cubmaster of the Year, and can be earned by any registered volunteer at the unit level. In order to receive the award, the recipient and presenter must be present at the annual recognition dinner.

How is the MVS determined? Get your unit committee and leaders together to nominate an outstanding leader based on the amount of service given during the past year. Select the MVS and who will present the award. All recipients will receive a wall certificate suitable for framing.

Remember, this is a unique award for unit level volunteers. You may nominate someone for the Most Valuable Scouter Award using this form, and nominate someone for a distinguished district award using the nomination form on the reverse side.

Remember to have the nomination form in before the March Roundtable to Don Campbell. This is a great way to say thanks to a deserving volunteer.
