

# Year 2008 Reservation Fees

Phone Reservations begin 8:00 a.m. central time on April 2, 2007

Fees include Interpreter (staff member), full outfitting, lodging at base before and after trip, all meals, shower, and sauna. Each group will have an Interpreter join the crew when they arrive. For our billing, he or she is not considered to be a crew member. Partial outfitting available. Contact us for details.

**ADDITIONAL FEES MAY BE REQUIRED:**

The following fees are based on the previous year's costs and are subject to change.

**Fees from Ely (C.L. Sommers Base)**

Regular Season: 6/12 through August. Early Season: 6/5, 6, 7 & 8 - 9 or 10 day trips only

**Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness**

- Reservation fee of \$12.00, user fee of \$10.00 per adult and \$5.00 per youth per trip. Crew also pays for Interpreter's user fee. The reservation fee and \$20.00 deposit will be paid to the Northern Tier (we will have already secured your permit in advance). The remainder of the user fees will be paid with crew credit card to the reservation provider upon arrival at the base.
- Guide-Outfitter fee of 25 cents per person (not including the interpreter) per day (on the water). This fee will be paid to the Northern Tier. It is a fee we are required to collect and pay to the United States Forest Service.

**Quetico Provincial Park (in Canadian dollars, roughly 90% of U.S. dollars)**

- \$12.00 permit fee, \$100 deposit\*, \$18.00 per adult and \$8.00 per youth per night camping in the park. Crew also pays camping fee for Interpreter. The permit fee and deposit will be paid to the Northern Tier, the camping fees (less deposit) will be paid at the ranger station upon entering the park.
- \$30.00 per adult for "Remote Area Border Crossing" permit. These fees will be paid ahead of time to the Canadian Government.
- \$30.00 per crew (in U.S. dollars) to cover Interpreter work permits for Canadian trips. This fee will be paid to the Northern Tier. We are required to pay this fee to the Canadian Government.

**Fees from Atikokan (Donald Rogert Base) 6/12 through August**

**Quetico Provincial Park (in Canadian dollars, roughly 90% of U.S. dollars):**

- \$12.00 permit fee, \$100 deposit\*, \$13.00 per adult and \$6.00 per youth per night camping in the park. Crew also pays camping fee for Interpreter. The permit fee and deposit will be paid to the Northern Tier, the camping fees (less deposit) will be paid at the ranger station upon entering the park.

**North of Atikokan in White Otter-Turtle River Wilderness or other Crown Lands:**

- Shuttle fees included in regular fee to normal drop-off and pick-up points.

**Fees from Bissett (Northern Expeditions) 6/15 through August**

- Float plane fly-in, fly-out **Round Trip** fees of approximately \$160.00 per person in **U.S. Dollars**. Crew also pays flying fee for Interpreter. These fees will be paid to the float plane provider.

**CREW SIZE: (May bring multiple crews)**

**Atikokan:** If going north, maximum crew size is 12, including Interpreter. If going south into Quetico Park, maximum crew size is 9, including Interpreter.

**Bissett:** Maximum crew size is 12, including Interpreter.

**Ely:** Maximum crew size is 9, including Interpreter.

**NORTHERN TIER FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE:**

\$300.00 deposit per crew - Due within 3 weeks of reservation with "Reservation Form."  
 \$1,000.00 per crew additional - Due Oct. 1, 2007 (or within 3 weeks of reservations, whichever is later)  
 Balance of Payment - June crews - March 1, July crews - April 1, August crews - May 1.  
 Individual participant fees non-refundable after this date.  
**(All fees non-refundable and non-transferable to balance of fees due.)**

**2008 CANOEING RESERVATION APPLICATION**

Thank you for choosing the Northern Tier programs for your wilderness adventure. Please carefully read the following information before making your reservation.

**NORTHERN TIER PARTICIPANT AGE REQUIREMENTS:**

To participate in High Adventure programs operated by the Northern Tier, a participant must be a registered Boy Scout, Varsity Scout, or Venturer. Youth participants **must** have attained the age of 13 by the date of arrival. **THESE ARE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS!**

Please remember that high adventure programs are designed for older youth members as an incentive to keep them in the program. The programs of the Northern Tier are challenging and rigorous. Use good judgment in choosing your crew members.

**ADULT LEADERSHIP:**

The best available adult leadership should be recruited to accompany each crew. In keeping with the policy of the Boy Scouts of America there are no gender restrictions for adult leadership at the Northern Tier, except that each coed crew must have coed adult advisors.

Each Northern Tier crew must have at least two registered adult leaders, or one adult and one parent, one of whom must be 21 years of age or older. Because Northern Tier's objective is to serve youth, every crew **must** have a majority of youth participants.

**COED EXPEDITIONS:**

The Northern Tier invites chartered coed Venturing Crews to participate in High Adventure Expeditions. Each coed group is required to provide adult coed leadership (each must be at least 21 years of age) while en route to and from, as well as while participating in the Northern Tier programs.

**RESERVATIONS:**

- 1) You must phone the base to receive a crew number and tentatively reserve a trip date. You then have **three weeks** to send in your reservation form and the \$300 per crew reservation fee (deposit). After three weeks, the reservation is subject to cancellation.
- 2) **FILL OUT THE ENCLOSED RESERVATION APPLICATION FORM COMPLETELY including council signature** and mail, along with a deposit of \$300 per crew (which is applied to your total fee) to secure your reservation. This deposit is not refundable if you cancel, and is not transferable from one crew to another.
- 3) **Reservations for the 2008 season begin at 8:00 AM Central Time on Monday, April 2, 2007.**
