CARE BUCKETS FOR HAITI

We are currently collecting hygiene packages to be sent to Haiti. We are asking units - Troops, Packs, Crews, Dens or Patrols (NOT individuals) to fill 5 gallon construction buckets with NEW items such as:

- Baby wipes or wet wipes
- Buckets
- Non-liquid soap
- Wash cloths
- Toothpaste
- Toothbrushes
- Combs and Brushes

Please no shampoos or any materials that might leak. We are NOT collecting used/new clothing or shoes at the moment. We are also NOT collecting medicines or other medical supplies.

These buckets will be added into the containers the Brothers Brother Foundation will be sending off to Haiti in the coming weeks.

COLLECTION SUGGESTIONS:

In addition to collections at unit meetings, consider setting up at businesses around your community:

- Grocery stores like: Giant Eagle, Shop N Save, etc.
- Department stores like: Walmart, Sam's Club, Costco, Target, K-Mart, etc.
- Drugstores like: Walgreens, Rite Aid, CVS, etc.
- Shopping malls, dollar stores, roundtables, Courts of Honor, Blue & Gold banquets, etc.
- Get your school or church involved (be sure to make an announcement a week in advance of the collection)

When you set-up at a store, have copies of the small flyer (next page) listing the items you are collecting and hand these out as people ENTER the store. Ask them to pick up an extra item or two for the victims of the Haiti earthquake and drop them off on their way out of the store! (Be sure to collect and reuse the flyers)

Wearing the Scout uniform IS recommended when working on this service project!

All filled buckets must be delivered to Brothers Brother by February 26
