

## BADEN-POWELL HONOR TROOP AWARD

Initial	Requirements
	1. 50% of the patrols in your troop must earn the Green Bar Bill Honor Patrol Award.
	2. Show that your unit maintains a safe and healthy campsite by earning points on the Commissioner's Daily Visitation according to the following guidelines: Monday - 40 points or above Wednesday - 43 points or more Friday - 47 points or more
	3. Create a small (no more than one foot square) centerpiece for each of your Troop's Dining tables that are somehow indicative of the membership of your patrol or troop.
	4. Participate in the Camp wide Game.
	5. Have 100% Scout and Leader participation in the camp evaluation process. The Senior Patrol Leader will be given a blank evaluation form, and in consultation with all the Scouts, fill the form out so that it reflects the Troop membership's opinion. The forms must be turned in to the camp office by 5:00 PM on Friday.
	6. Build a Troop Gateway to your site. (Must be removed prior to departing camp.)
	7. Participate in a camp service project with at least 50% of your Troop for at least 1 hour during the week. Troop is encouraged to invite their site guide to participate in the service project.

\* Have your Scoutmaster initial each requirement as it is completed. Turn this form in to your Commissioner by noon on Friday.
